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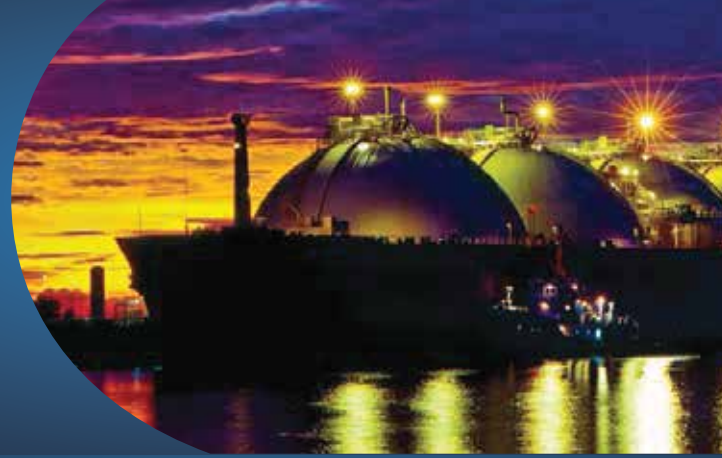
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RATIONALE BEHIND THE 2018 EVENT

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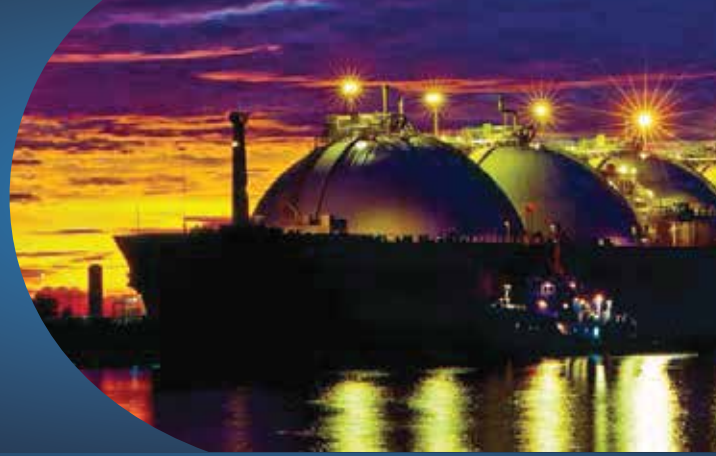
